- Four DNHL levels (Squirt, PeeWee, Bantam, Midget).
 - o 14 Squirt games, 14 PeeWee games, 16 Bantam games & 20 Midget games.
 - o 1 practice and 1 game per week.
 - o Games on Saturdays or Sundays
 - o Play teams from Denver to Ft. Collins
- CDYHL level teams (Based on tryouts).
3-4 weekend overnight trips to play Mountain team.
 - o Squirt B: 14 games & 18 practices.
 - o PeeWee B: 16 games & 20 practices.
 - o Bantam B: 18 games & 22 practices.
 - o Midget A: 20 games & 36 practices.

#6. Lower Cost to Play.

- Team fees are significantly lower than other local associations (no rinks to pay for, no full time staff to pay, no teams to subsidize).
